German Intensive Language Course

Every Monday to Friday from 9.00–10.30 and 11.00–12.30, one some course days lessons in the afternoon (see course schedule). In total 68 academic hours/teaching units, 45 minutes each.

Aims and Contents

Grundstufe (beginner)

Introduction to linguistic skills and structures which are useful in everyday life including German culture.

Mittelstufe (intermediate level) and Oberstufe (advanced level)

More advanced language skills, preparation for linguistically challenging tasks (newspaper reading, writing, discussions, etc.), and improvement of academic language skills.

Credits

With full attendance (regular and active participation, homework and tests), up to 6 ECTS credits can be awarded.

Absences count towards the reduction of ECTS as follows:

- 6 ECTS: absence of up to 6 teaching units
- 4 ECTS: absence of 7-12 teaching units (only with doctor's certificate)

0 ECTS: absence of more than 12 teaching units


