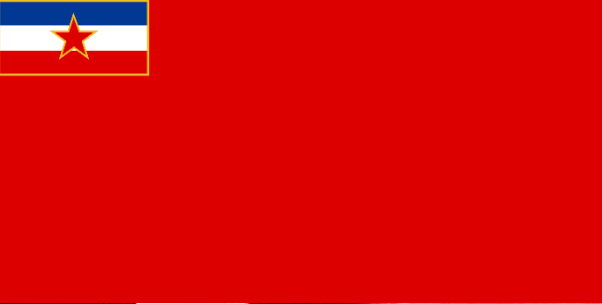
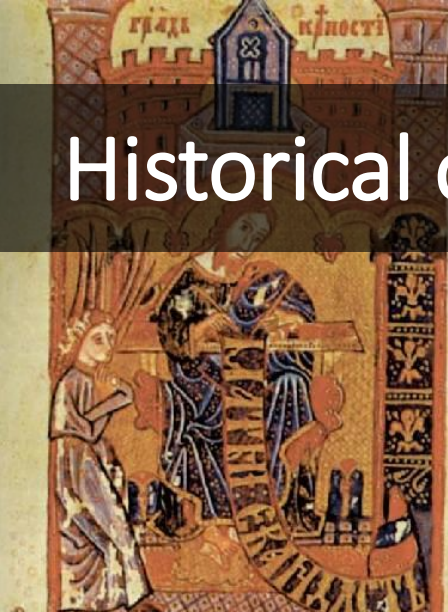

Placed in the heart of Europe with mixture of Mediterranean and continental climate (cold Winters and hot Summers).


Historical overview

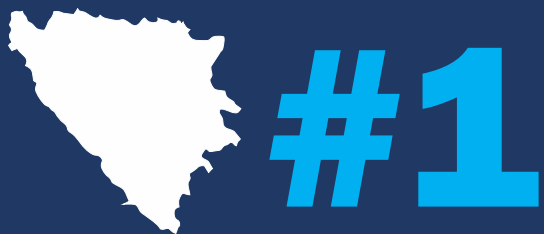


It is the largest student city in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

University of Sarajevo is the best higher education institution in the country (in local and international rankings)



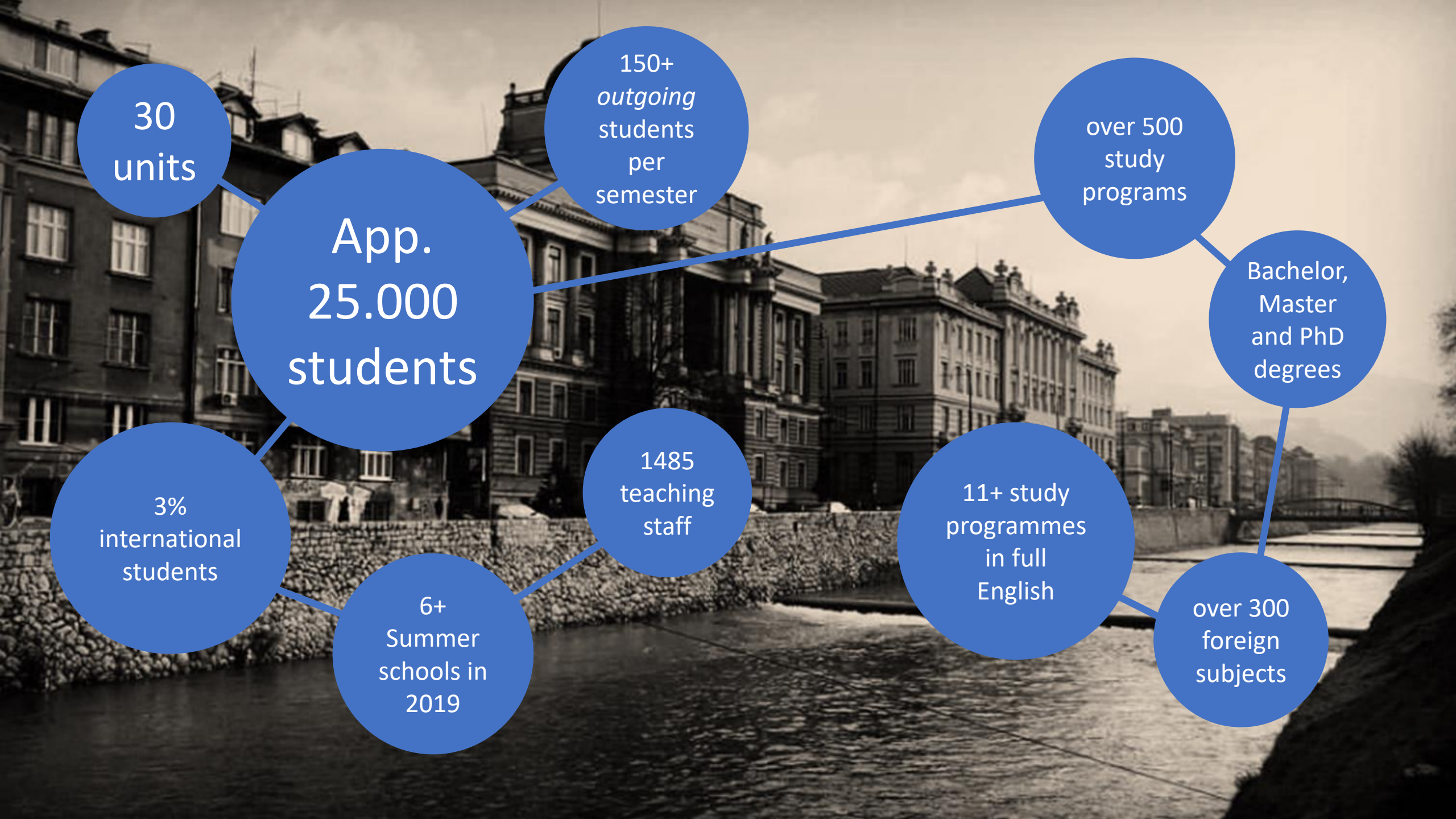
