How to set up the opt-in precondition in ILIAS

Goal:


 Course participants should be given access to specific course content, e.g. web conferences, after consenting to the data protection information. The opt-in precondition documents such consent.

Steps:

- Add a **test** (test item) with only a single question about consenting to the data protection information. The test is "passed" when participants answer the "single answer" question by choosing the "consent" option.
- Use the "availability" option to limit access to any ILIAS item (e.g. the BBB videoconferencing item or a link to a WebEx or Zoom videoconference).
- You can change the settings so that this content only becomes visible after the test is "passed".
- Students can complete the test as often as they like, meaning that they can withdraw
 their consent at any time. Their ability to access the respective content will, however,
 change as a result.
- The results of every test are documented.

3. Add the declaration of consent to the question


1. Give your question a title and list yourself as the author



4. Define possible responses


1. Click "+" to add a second line for responses



5. Find the course URL





13. Another option: Use a weblink item for WebEx or Zoom videoconferences


1. You can use the same precondition method for other course items, e.g. weblinks. Add the "weblink" item...

4. Important: If you would like to edit the text for the declaration of consent later, then you must delete all the previous test data and have all users give their consent again. If desired, please export all the old user responses first!

1. Click on the "results" tab for the test item

2. The test was "passed", meaning the user gave his/her consent

3. Click on the downward arrow to show all the user's responses (see next slide)

15. Documentation of consent



1. Showing all the user's responses (as described in the previous slide) allows you to see both the final response and whether a user changed his/her response
